



SUMMER TIPS:

WATERING:

Your new plants will need plenty of water as the weather heats up. Be sure not to neglect them, especially in full sun areas. They will need your help in the first weeks and months until they become established. If you go on vacation, ask a neighbor to water for you.

TRIMMING:



Evergreens will be getting their new growth. To make them thicker, you may trim some of the new growth mid-June to August. In most cases you can cut off as much as you like to receive the shape you desire without harming the tree. However, if you cut too far into the old wood it will take longer for them to fill in and have a desirable look.

OTHER CARE:

Fungus diseases are common as the weather becomes more humid. Spraying with a proper fungicide should help these conditions. Buy quality plants from a nursery that knows plants!
