It is believed that the ancestry of many Chinese chestnuts came from the warm climate zone in China. A good reason why many are for zone 5 or warmer areas and have a rough chance of surviving in Wisconsin. *However*, Wolfrath's grow several Chinese cross chestnuts from cooler areas of northern China that are sweet, blight resistant and have a much better chance of survival in Wisconsin. These are self pollinating, but are best planted in groups of 3 to 5 trees.
